#### GOLDEN TRIANGLE TOUR

The Golden Triangle is so called because of the triangular shape formed by the locations of New Delhi, Agra and Rajasthan on a map. The trips usually start in Delhi moving south to the site of Taj Mahal at Agra, then west, to the desert landscapes of Rajasthan. It is normally possible to do the trip by coach or private journey through most tour operators. The Golden Triangle is now a well traveled route providing a good spectrum of the country's different landscapes. The circuit is about 720 km by road. Each leg is about 4 to 6 hours of drive.

#### RAJPUTANA ON WHEELS



This Indian state has many surprises, not least the temperatures it can deliver. We will be travelling in winter here and although it is likely to be very warm in the daytime, temperatures drop sharply at night. This is beneficial to getting a good kip, but things can be chilly, or downright cold, during early starts. Due to this it is recommended that you bring sufficient warm clothes to cope with riding temperatures down to about 5°C (for brief periods), while also being equipped to ride in the low-thirties.

- **Day 01**: In Jaipur extensive briefing before you take a short ride to Amber town
- **Day 02:** Leaving Jaipur, you'll head southwest on NH 8 towards Ajmer to the town of Pushkar, a holy town famous for its lake, various ghats and temples spread all around it.
- Day o3: In the morning you'll saddle-up yet again for a 215 Km ride to the city of Jodhpur.
- **Day 04:** Jodhpur (Sight-seeingday) including Mehrangarh Fort, Umaid Bhawan Palace, Jaswant Thada or the bazaars around the clock tower.
- **Day 05**: After Breakfast ride your Bullet to Ranakpur, & final destination today will be a small village of Kelwara situated 6 KM from Kumbhalgarh.
- **Day 06:** Kumbhalgarh This impregnable fort fell only once to the combined forces of four kingdoms including Emperor Akbar.
- **Day 07:** Udaipur, a tourist's delight as it is, will most likely have you spending the entire day visiting all it has to offer.
- **Day 08:** Heading north-east from Udaipur, today's ride takes us to the spectacular fort of Chittorgarh, After a ride to the Fort, you'll continue further towards the village of Bijaipur.
- **Day 09:** About 150 Km north-east of Bijaipur lies the quaint town of Bundi. Site of yet another impressive fort, the Taragarh,
- **Day 10 :** Today's destination lies further north-east of Bundi and is home to the famous Royal Bengal Tiger. Ranthmabore National Park safari.
- **Day 11** : Today you'll saddle-up one last time and head back to Jaipur. Tonight's dinner will be a "Farewell" dinner.
